Ticket Purchase

Seating Information

Seating is assigned, so the tickets you purchase are your designated seats for the show.

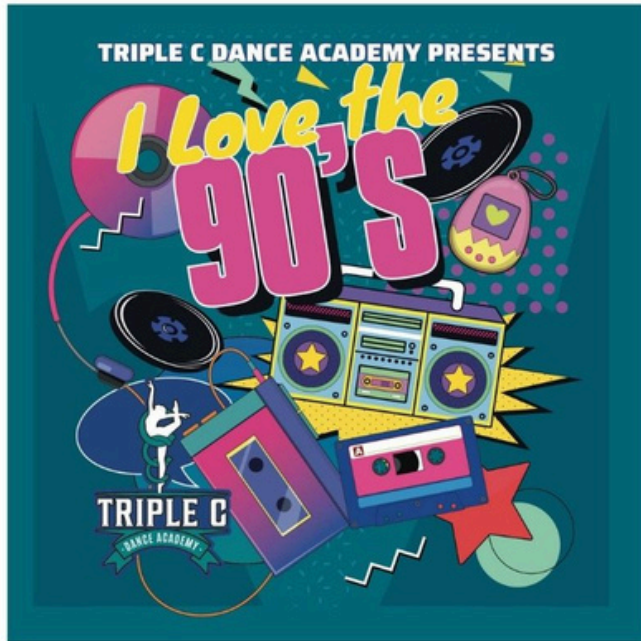
Children sitting on a parent's lap do not need a ticket. However, because seating is assigned, if you do not purchase a seat for your child, they must sit in your lap. They cannot sit in the seat next to you.

At-the-Door Sales

A limited number of tickets may be available at the door for an increased price. Door sales are cash only.

Important Entry Details

- Every person entering the theater must have their own ticket, unless sitting on a parent's lap.
- Please screenshot your tickets in advance, as cell signal may be limited at the venue.
- Share your ticket screenshots with any family members or guests not arriving with you.
- We cannot admit guests without a ticket, even if someone in your party is already inside.

Ticket sales for the Spring Recital will open on Wednesday, April 1st at 9:00 AM. At the same time, families will also have the option in their Parent Portal to purchase program ads and pre-order flowers, recital t-shirts, stuffed animals, and dance bags (your dancer will receive one t-shirt as part of their costume).

Families will no longer have the option in their Parent Portal to purchase program ads, flowers, recital t-shirts, stuffed animals, or dance bags. Ticket sales will remain open online until May 8th.

DRESS REHEARSAL

Date: Friday, May 8th

Time: 6:00–9:00 PM

Location: Lehigh Senior High School

(901 Gunnery Road N, Lehigh Acres, Florida 33971)

The Recital Dress Rehearsal is a **mandatory** event for all dancers participating in the recital. As this is the only opportunity for dancers to rehearse on stage, adjust spacing, practice transitions, and prepare in full costume, any dancer who does not attend **will not** be permitted to perform in the recital. Please make all necessary arrangements to ensure your dancer is present for the entire rehearsal.

Arrival & Attire:

- Tiny Twirl & Level 1 Dancers must arrive in their costumes. Level 2-3 dancers must arrive in their opening number attire (recital t-shirt & black leggings), including proper tights, hair, and accessories. Dancers should arrive on time so rehearsals can run smoothly and stay on schedule.
- Families with dancers age 6 and under who are participating in multiple dances and require a costume change will be asked to confirm whether they will assist their dancer with the costume change or request studio assistance. Families requesting studio assistance agree that their dancer will wear a skin-colored leotard underneath their costume to allow for quick and appropriate costume changes. Skin-colored leotards can be purchased on the studio's site under the “recital gear” section

What to Expect:

- Rehearsal will follow the recital order, giving dancers the opportunity to practice routines with stage lighting and spacing.
- Food will be provided for all dancers. If your dancer has allergies or dietary restrictions, please notify the studio in advance.

Important Reminders:

- Hair must be styled according to class requirements prior to check-in.
- Please bring a labeled water bottle for your dancer.

Your cooperation helps us create a smooth and successful recital experience for every dancer.

RECITAL DAY

The recital will take place on Saturday, May 9th at Lehigh Senior High School. All dancers are required to arrive at the theater by 10:00 AM for check-in and final preparations.

- The recital performance will run from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM. Tiny Twirls & Level 1 Dancers must arrive fully dressed in their recital costume. Level 2-3 dancers must arrive in their opening number outfit (recital t-shirt, black leggings & tights), with all costume pieces neatly packed in a labeled garment bag.
- Hair must be styled in a high bun and secured with the assigned costume hairpiece. Please ensure dancers are performance-ready upon arrival, as this helps the day run smoothly and on schedule.

Costume Changes for Young Dancers:

Families with dancers age 6 and under who are participating in multiple dances and require a costume change will be asked to confirm whether they will assist their dancer with the costume change or request studio assistance. Families requesting studio assistance agree that their dancer will wear a skin-colored leotard underneath their costume to allow for quick and appropriate costume changes.



ATTIRE INFORMATION

The recital fee for the Spring Recital includes:

- Costume and hairpieces
- Skin-colored tights
- Recital t-shirt
- Recital video

Parents are responsible for providing the following items:

- Level 1-3 dancers: Black leggings for the opening and closing numbers
- Skin-colored leotard for dancers age 6 and under if parents request the studio's help with costume changes
- Ballet classes: Pink ballet shoes
- Contemporary classes: Barefoot (rolled up convertible tights)
- Intro to Dance classes: Barefoot (rolled up convertible tights)
- Level 1 Ballet/Jazz: Black sneakers purchased as a group
- Level 1 Gymnastics/Dance: Barefoot (rolled up convertible tights)
- Level 3 Jazz/Contemporary: Black jazz shoes

PARKING INFORMATION

When arriving at the school:

- Drive past the guard house (on your left) and the administration office (also on your left).
- Continue to the back of the school and park inside the fenced parking lot (on your left).

Auditorium Entrance:

- Enter through the open gate to the left of the parking lot (when facing the school) and follow the walkway to the auditorium.



DROP OFF/PICK UP

- When you arrive for the rehearsal and recital, a parent or guardian will need to sign in each dancer.
- At the conclusion of rehearsal and recital, all students will be released by class from the stage.
- If there is a reason your dancer cannot be released from the stage, please speak with us prior to rehearsal and recital weekend so we can make the necessary accommodations.

HAIR & MAKEUP

We recommend that every dancer wear stage makeup, although it is not required. Stage lights are very bright and can wash out facial features, making it difficult for the audience to see the dancer's face. Properly applied makeup also helps ensure your dancer's face is visible in photos and videos.



Make-Up

For stage makeup, we recommend using volumizing mascara to make the eyes stand out, a bold blush to add warmth and definition under bright lights, and a vibrant lip color that complements the costume. These touches help ensure every expression is visible and radiant on stage.



Hair

To create a polished and uniform look on stage, all dancers should wear their hair in a high bun, secured neatly and adorned with the hairpiece or bow that comes with their costume.

Always test makeup prior to dance recital week, to make sure your child doesn't have any sensitivities or allergies to the products you use!
